All are requested to go through all instructions carefully for smooth conduction of examination.

Guideline of Online Examination

Syllabus for Examination

TE (2019 pattern) - Unit 1 and 2 BE(2015 Pattern) - Unit 1, 2, 3

- 2. Mode of Execution
- Google Meet Platform through google form
- Proctored based examination through google meet, google form based question paper and continuously monitored through camera.
- 3. Timing
- TE: 10 am to 10.40 am.
- BE: 2 pm to 2.40 pm
- 4. Insem Examination will be of 30 marks based on MCQ only
- 5. Total 36 questions will be asked, out of that any 30 correctly answered questions will be considered.
- 6. For TE 18 questions on each unit will be asked
- For BE 12 questions on each unit will be asked

Instructions to Students

- This exam will be conducted through proctored method.
- 2. All the students should ensure proper system with proper camera, microphone and network connection.
- 3. Once exam will start students are not supposed to change the screen, switch tab or minimize tab.

- 4. Background noise is recorded through microphone during exam and if relevant discussion to questions and answers of exam is found then that case will be treated as a copy case.
- 5. Video is recorded using system camera once student start exam. If student is missing from camera during exam or found miscellaneous then it will be treated as a copy case.
- 6. All the students need to submit paper within timeline. If any student not submitted paper within a given timeline then record of such paper not be maintained and student will be considered as Absent.
- 7. If any problem occurred during exam because of any reason such as poor network, electricity failure then student should immediately contact to subject teacher.
- 8. No student would be allowed to *change/extend time slot* for examination
- 9. If any problem occurred during exam at student end and if it is not communicated to teacher then students will be fully responsible for the exam result.
